TOXNET® Databases on toxicology, hazardous chemicals, environmental health, and toxic releases.

ChemIDplus® Online dictionary of chemical substances cited in NLM databases and other Internet resources. Advanced version includes chemical structure, toxicity, and physical property searching

Comparative Toxicogenomics Database (CTD)

Elucidates molecular mechanisms by which environmental chemicals affect human disease

Hazardous Substances Data Bank (HSDB®) Comprehensive, peer-reviewed toxicology and environmental data for chemicals, including information on physical properties and safety and handling

Household Products Database (HPD) Information on the health effects, handling, and disposal of chemicals found in common household products

Integrated Risk Information System (IRIS)

Hazard identification and dose-response assessments for chemicals

International Toxicity Estimates for Risk (ITER)

Risk information for chemicals from authoritative groups worldwide

LactMed® (Drugs and Lactation Database) Database of drugs and other chemicals to which breastfeeding mothers may be exposed and the effects of those agents on nursing infants and lactation

TOXMAP® Interactive environmental health maps showing locations of toxic chemical releases and hazardous waste sites

Toxics Release Inventory (TRI) Annual environmental releases of toxic chemicals by U.S. facilities

TOXLINE® Bibliographic database of toxicology references

AIDSinfo® Drug Database Information on FDA-approved and investigational HIV/AIDS-related drugs.

ChemSpell Web Service Application Programming Interface (API) providing chemical name spell checking and chemical name synonym look up. Contains more than 1.3 million chemical names related to organic, inorganic, pharmaceutical, toxicological, and environmental health topics.

ClinicalTrials.gov Searchable database providing information about current ongoing clinical research studies and drugs and treatments.

Dietary Supplement Label Database (DSLDB)

Collaborative project between the Office of Dietary Supplements (ODS) at NIH and NLM, containing full label contents from U.S. marketed dietary supplements and providing search features important for researchers.

Drug Information Portal Portal to current drug information from NLM and other Federal agencies. Information on drugs from the time that they are in clinical trials, through their FDA approval process, and then on to the marketplace. Coverage includes drugs with official generic name status such as USAN (United States Adopted Name) or INN (International Nonproprietary Name).

LiverTox® Comprehensive clinical and research information and a case registry on liver injury attributable to about 1,000 prescription and nonprescription drugs, herbals, and dietary supplements.

Pillbox Enables rapid identification of unknown solid-dosage medication based on physical characteristics and high quality images.

PubChem® Information on the biological activities of small molecules. PubChem includes substance information, compound structures, and BioActivity data in three primary databases: PubChem Substance, PubChem Compound, and PubChem BioAssay.

Online resource enabling first responders and other health care providers and planners to plan for, respond to, recover from, and mitigate the effects of mass-casualty incidents involving accidental or terrorist chemical releases. CHEMM is downloadable so it can be used if the Internet is not available.
